**Professor Sumit Agarwal**

*Low Tuck Kwong Distinguished Professor of Finance, National University of Singapore, Singapore*

Sumit Agarwal is [Low Tuck Kwong Distinguished Professor of Finance at the Business School](#) and a Professor of [Economics](#) and [Real Estate](#) at the [National University of Singapore](#). He is the Managing Director of [Sustainable and Green Finance Institute](#) at NUS. He is also the President of [Asian Bureau of Finance and Economic Research](#).

In the past, he has held positions as a Professor of Finance at the Business School, Georgetown University. Before that he was a senior financial economist in the research department at the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago and prior to joining the Chicago Fed, he was a senior vice president and credit risk management executive in the Small Business Risk Solutions Group of Bank of America.

Sumit's research interests include issues relating to household sustainability, financial institutions, household finance, behavioral finance, and real estate markets. He has published over one hundred and twenty five research articles in economics and finance journals among others. Additionally, he has co-written six books titled [Why We Feel Blue When the Air is Grey](#), [Kiasunomics 3](#), [Introduction to Household Financial Management](#), [Kiasunomics 2](#), [Household Finance: A Functional Approach](#), and [Kiasunomics](#), and also co-edited two collected volumes titled [Impact of COVID-19 on Asian Economies and Policy Responses](#), and [Household Credit Usage: Personal Debt and Mortgages](#). He writes regular op-ed's in the Straits Times and is featured on various media outlets like the CNA, BBC, CNBC, and Fox on issues relating to finance, banking, and real estate markets. Sumit's research is widely cited in leading newspapers and magazines like the Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, The Economist, and the U.S Presidents Report to Congress. He also runs a Podcast on household financial decision making called [Kiasunomics](#).

**Mr. Paul Conway**

*Director of Economics/Chief Economist, Reserve Bank of New Zealand, New Zealand*

Paul Conway became the Reserve Bank’s Director of Economics and Chief Economist in May 2022. He joined the Reserve Bank from BNZ where he had been Chief Economist since January 2021.

Before joining BNZ Paul spent 7 years as the Director of Economics and Research at the New Zealand Productivity Commission. Much of Paul’s work at the Commission was focused on firm-level productivity and understanding the obstacles New Zealand businesses face in using technology to improve performance.

Paul has extensive international experience and has previously worked at the OECD and with the World Bank. Paul initially started his career at the Reserve Bank as an economist after studying at Victoria of University of Wellington and Otago University.
